WHAT WE DO. GET ACTIVE.

The Fairmount Civic Association (FCA) helps to **maintain and protect the historic, cultural, and economic vitality of one of Philadelphia's most exciting, vibrant neighborhoods.** A few of our many projects include:

Community Meetings. The FCA holds monthly meetings in the neighborhood to update residents on current events, provide a forum for guest speakers, and allow residents to voice concerns.

The TreeVitalize Program. Our greening program identifies spots around the neighborhood where new trees can be planted and old trees removed.

Community Safety Liaison. Members of the FCA work with the 9th and 22nd police districts to share resident concerns and pass on important safety information.

Local Scholarship Program. The FCA provides local education awards to students from three neighborhood schools.

The FCA has a variety of committees that take an active role in making Fairmount the strongest possible neighborhood. **Pick a committee and get involved!**

Neighborhood Improvement. Works to address issues related to neighborhood clean-ups, recycling, gardens, parks, and other green activities.

Education. Focuses on working with Fairmount parents, children, and local schools to provide the best possible educational opportunities.

Parking and Transportation. Addresses issues related to SEPTA, bicycles, car sharing, parking, and other transportation issues in the neighborhood.

Zoning. Works to ensure that Fairmount residents have a voice in the development of both residential and commercial properties.

Activities. Organizes FCA events, trips, and social gatherings for members and neighborhood residents.
